



Pauline R. Lewis

December 26, 1938 - February 7, 2025

Pauline Robinson Lewis was born on December 26, 1938 to the late James Richard and Louise Edna Wright Robinson in Harnett County, NC, the second of 13 children. The angels descended from heaven to transition Pauline to her heavenly home on February 7, 2025, in Clinton, MD.

Pauline's formal education began at Smith Grove School, a one room classroom in 1944. Later she attended Harnett High School from which she graduated in May 1956. While in high school, Pauline was a member of the Drama and Choral Club. She was a bright student making excellent grades and developed into a prolific speaker, which she displayed her entire life.

Pauline grew up in a Christian home which fostered her relationship with God throughout her adult life. She was a member of Trinity A.M.E. Zion in Dunn, NC where she was baptized. Pauline also sang in the church choir and was a dedicated usher who attended various conferences representing her church proudly.

In 1956, Pauline migrated to Washington, DC, where she attended Howard University for a brief period, while employed at S&W Cafeteria in Virginia. Pauline's professional career began with the U.S. Department of Labor as an accountant. She retired after 42 years of dedicated service. During her tenure with the U.S. Department of Labor, she attended George Washington

University to receive relative training to further her career. Pauline earned many training certificates and performance awards during her successful career.

Gilbert Chancor Eugene Lewis, Sr., married Pauline on February 24, 1962, at Trinity A.M.E. Zion Church in Dunn, NC. To this union, one son Gilbert C. E. Lewis, Jr., was born. Prior to their union, Pauline welcomed a joyful baby boy, Michael Roman Robinson, into the world. She was a loving and devoted mother to both. Pauline loved the Lord while persistently studying the Bible under Dr. Frederick K. Price and home studies with Rev. Robert Carter, her brother-in-Love. She shared her teaching with others as she gained knowledge, especially with her sisters. She frequently attended Franklin P. Nash Methodist Church in Washington, DC.

Pauline was very active with local politics, working with the Prince George's County Board of Elections and School Board, Congressman Steny Hoyer, Gloria Lawlah, and volunteered for Rev. Jesse Jackson on his historic Presidential run. She was an advocate for quality educational programs geared towards equity and inclusion. Furthermore, she made many contributions to various charitable organizations and political affiliations. She also worked with the Harnett High School Alumni Association and the Hillcrest Towne Homeowner's Association. Pauline's generosity, love for her entire family and kind nature were remarkable. She had a wonderful sense of humor; she would often use the phrase "study to be quiet" when dealing with her loquacious sisters.

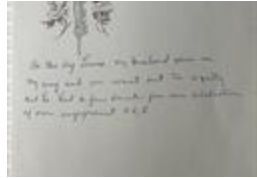

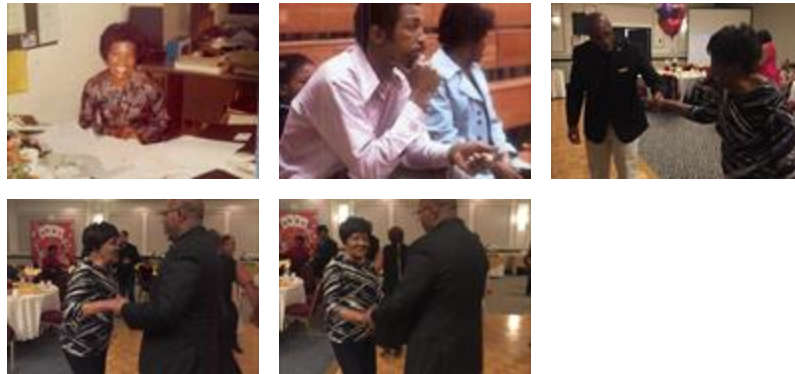
