Percy Johnson, Jr. was born November 4, 1925 in Ensley (Jefferson County), AL to Naomi and Percy Johnson, Sr. While living in the south, Percy was baptized at an early age. He attended Parker High School in Birmingham, AL. At the age of 17, Percy was drafted into the US Navy during WWII. During his tour of duty, he became very ill and was not expected to live, but by the grace of God, he survived. After being honorably discharged from the Navy, Percy joined his family in Washington, DC where he met and married Revell Powell in 1948.
