April 6, 1933 - May 1, 2020

Queen Ann Holliday, age 87, of Washington, DC passed away at her home surrounded by family members on May 1, 2020.

Queen was born on April 6, 1933, in Freemont, NC. She was the youngest of six children born to Benjamin and Elizabeth (née Crummedy) Green.
