Rhonda “Rocki” L. Green, 38, died on Sunday, August 28, 2022, from a rare form of cancer. In hospice care two months prior to her death, Rhonda died peacefully in her sleep.

Rhonda was born in Washington, D.C. on November 6, 1983, to Barbara A. Green and Ronald E. Dixon. Rhonda received her primary education in the District of Columbia Public Schools. She graduated from Eastern High School in 2001.
