Rudolph migrated to the USA in 1964 and continued his education at Howard University where he received his B.A and M.A degrees. He received his PHD in English from the Catholic University of America in 1978. Rudolph taught English Grammar at several institutions, including the University of The District of Columbia (UDC) and The Community College of Baltimore County

(CCBC) where he worked for 20 years. He was the author of several English grammar books: A Grammar Workbook, English Fundamentals, ENGL 015 and Writing Through Grammar that are published and one that he was working on at the time of his passing.

Rudolph loved sports. As a youth he played cricket with his friends Sir Clive Lloyd, CBE at the Demerara Cricket Club in Georgetown and at Howard University. He also loved tennis so much that he and Ruby were season ticket holders to the Citi Tennis Tournament in DC. He also was a die-hard fan of Redskins football team.

Rudolph was very contented, kind and giving person. He loved to entertain family when they stopped by his home. He would use those occasions to start heated discussions on various topics especially sports and politics. He will be greatly missed. May his soul rest in peace.
