May 29, 1938 - January 3, 2022

The sunrise of Samuel Hardy's life was on May 29, 1938, when his parents, the late Ruth Hardy and James Hatchett were blessed with his birth. Samuel Hardy of Temple Hills, Maryland, departed this life peacefully at the age of 83 on Monday, January 3, 2022, at his residence after experiencing an illness. He received his education in Danville, Virginia where he met his devoted wife, Mozelle V. Hardy at Gibson Elementary School.

On July 3, 1956 Samuel married Mozelle and to that union a son Emmanuel Hardy was born. This completed his family. Their marriage of 65 years epitomizes strength, dedication, loyalty and love.

Samuel Hardy was self-employed as a taxi cab driver with Yellow Cab, Madison Taxi and other cab companies. He ultimately retired from Yellow Cab many years ago. He also owned an ice cream truck which later turned into a food truck.

"Red Toe" was his name. He even painted the toe area of one of his bowling shoes red. Samuel bowled in many leagues within the DC Metropolitan area, and traveled out of state for tournaments in Ohio and New York.

He enjoyed cooking, styling hair, playing games, eating seafood and spending

time with family. He also enjoyed watching Westerns and Judge Judy. Harrington Raceway & Casino and Dover Downs Casino were two of his favorite places. If he could have went to either of these casinos every weekend, we are more than sure that he would have gone!
