Born March 21, 1994, Shar came directly from the hospital to the family home in Fort Washington and was raised in a loving village that included her Grandparents, the late Shirley A. and Charles E. Miller, Sr., Great-Aunt, Carol Bain, and her Uncle who later adopted her, Charles E. Miller, Jr.

She attended The Holy Family School (Temple Hills, MD), graduating in 2008 to attend Eleanor Roosevelt High School (Greenbelt, MD). After graduation in 2012, Sharmayne went on to attend the University of Maryland, Eastern Shore where she majored in Criminal Justice.

Shar was a lifelong member of Hughes Memorial United Methodist Church, where she was the last baby to be baptized in the “Old Sanctuary” and one of her baby books is sealed in the church cornerstone. With a heart for God and spirit of service, she has served as an Acolyte, Junior Usher, an active member of Youth Ministries, even as Worship Leader in her youth and as a young adult, she’s been the youngest Women’s Day Chair, youngest Chair of the Church Council in the entire Baltimore-Washington Conference, youngest Communion Steward, and a member of the United Methodist Women.

With a vivid imagination, she was writing chapter books and selling her stories to her classmates as early as fourth grade. Always one to get a solo in the annual Christmas play, Shar blossomed in the Theater Department of Eleanor Roosevelt HS performing in their many productions.
