I went to college with Steve at NIU(Northern Illinois University). I have so many memories of Steve. Steve is the reason I chose Political Science as my major. We were both involved with student politics and unlike Steve I was not a good student initially. One day I asked him what his major was and why he chose it. After our conversation I decided that would be my major too. We both liked politics and activism and I figured if he liked it I would too, one of hte best decisions I've ever made.

We were in college when apartheid was thriving in South Africa. I was elected as BSU President and we had a meeting with the Student Leadership Council which included student leaders the University President and the Vice President of Student affairs and Steve went either because he was going to serve because I also had a position with the Student Government that I was going to accept or because he was the former president--either way I was nervous and excited as a newly elected president learning new things. I am all reved up about this meeting and what happens there and what I should do etc. Steve keeps saying don't worry about it. I trust him and begin to relax. We get to the meeting and Steve puts on this black glove. I'm thinking OK he needs Michael Jackson to help him feel comfortable. I think it's weird but Steve has always had a mind of his own.

As the meeting proceeds, Steve stands up and starts talking about divesting from South Africa--I remember two things clearly 1. we never discussed this and 2. what kind of an impression will this leave. Shortly after this event, NIU divested from South Africa. NIU had invested in the Krugerrand. I remember thinking, 1 how brave Steve was and 2. I am glad that I was there to see it in action. Steve was an interesting student and I respected him then and still respect him. It is never good to hear about the transition of a peer. I want his family to know that he was a good man who always stood on the right side of fairness. I heard the service and his Dad's remarks sound like the Steve that went to NIU. I'm glad I got to know him and spend time with him even though he went to my high school rival. I went to Hyde Park.
