July 21, 1945 - December 12, 2020

He was educated in the Campbell County school system and after completing High school he joined the US Navy. He served his country during the Vietnam war. He was Honorably Discharged and relocated to Washington DC. He then started his next journey with the US Department of Agriculture. He joined Isreal Baptist Church as served on the Deacon Board for over 40 years. He enjoyed cooking large meals for the church with his culinary crew. He was a member of the Virginia Club, Men's choir, IBC Choir and the culinary committee. After retiring from the Agriculture Department, he moved on to work for Israel Baptist Church as transportation driver and Head chef. During his time in the Navy he was on numerous Base Fastpitch Softball teams. He loved playing all sports but during his softball days he moved on to pinochle. He was also a diehard Cowboy fan and love cheering for his cowboys. 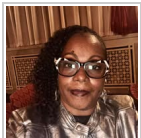

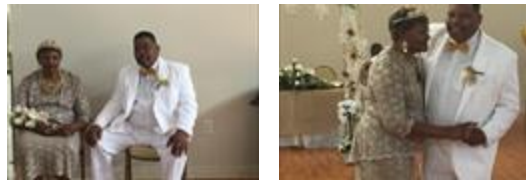
