Obituary

Thelma L. Williams, daughter of the late Newton and Maude Brackett, wife of the late Lawrence H. Williams, departed this life March 18, 2011, after a long illness at the Clinton Nursing, LLC in Clinton, MD.

Born in Albemarle County, VA, Thelma accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age. She was baptized and joined the First Baptist Church in Coveseville, VA. She attended grade school in Coveseville, and later attended Esmont High School for several semesters.

Thelma worked on a farm with her parents and also as a domestic worker for several years. After moving to Washington, DC in 1944, she continued her career as a domestic worker while attending Adult Education Programs at Roosevelt High School from which she received her GED. Then in 1972, she began working at the National Institutes of Health, and retired after 23 years of service. During her career there, she received several certificates and achievement awards.

In 1959, Thelma joined New Bethany Baptist Church, under the leadership of Rev. John J. Kolger. She was a member of the Flower Club.

Thelma is survived by two brother, John Brackett of Clinton,

MD and Harold Brackett of Alexandria, VA; five sisters-in-law, Florine, Elaine, Margaret, Ann Christine and Fannie; one brother-in-law, Harden Parks; a devoted goddaughter, Sarah V. Triplett; a granddaughter, Jeannette E. Williams, and a host of much loved nieces and nephews, other loving relatives and many friends.
