With humble hearts and enduring love, we celebrate the life of THEODORE THOMAS BROWN SR., a beloved husband, devoted father, proud grandfather, oldest and beloved brother, dedicated uncle, and faithful servant of God, he passed away peacefully on Friday, July 11, 2025, at the age of 75.

Born on September 19, 1949, in Baltimore, Maryland, Theodore was the cherished son of the late Booker Thomas Brown and late Jessie Lee Brown (Coleman).

Theodore was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated from Frederick Douglass High School, where he met the love of his life, Mrs. Naida Brown (Wilson). chicken wings, and steaks. He also loved to shop online, and especially his trips to Walmart and Costco with his precious wife and mother-in-law.
