Ubie received his formal education in the Washington District Public Schools. He began his career as machine press operator with the Washington Post where he retired after 30 years of dedicated service.

He loved anything and all things associated with horses and found himself traveling from state to state just to see horseracing. When he got to where he wasn't able to travel far he would find his way to Rosecroft Racetrack where he became the unofficial track announcer. If you wanted to find him all you had to do was show up at the racetrack and there he would be with those glasses hanging off the bridge of his nose and deep in the racing form. There was always a crowd around wanting a tip or two and just a little help to make a wager. He was well known and loved by many and all you had to do was to describe him or his cherry red scooter that he whipped around in like it was Cadillac Eldorado from back in the day. The response would always be the same "oh you talking about Fish" and they would tell you exactly where you could find him. His heart was so giving and didn't matter if you was young or old if you asked him for it he gave even if you didn't ask he still gave.

Always supporting a cause whether it was somebody selling pies, cakes dinners, or even kids selling candy he would be just give you the money and let you keep what you was selling. "Give it to somebody else" is what he would say. He had a love for people like no other but none could compare to the love he had for his grands and great-grands all they had to do was make one call and his response was simply "come pick it up".

Preceded him in death were his parents, his son Billy Brown, grandson Anthony Pettaway and two sisters Geneva Brown and Patricia Hicklin. 
