Willie Mae Majette, was born March 13, 1938 in Fuquay Springs, North Carolina. She was the daughter of Willard C. Floyd and Minnie Belle Floyd. She was the eldest child and had four siblings. She was married to Floyd Gerrell Majette Sr. for thirty-five years. They raised five children in Middletown, PA.

In the spring and in the summer she spent most of her time outside planting flowers and maintaining her garden. She always had her house filled with live plants.

Pennsylvania. She was the Women's Day Coordinator, she sang in the choir, and she taught Vacation Bible School. One of the highlights of her time in the choir was singing her solo, "Jesus Paid it All".

In her later years after her husband passed, she moved to Maryland to be closer to her children and grandchildren. She lived at the Selborne House in Laurel, Maryland. There she lead aerobics classes and had many friends.

In December of 2017 she re-dedicated her life to Jesus Christ.
